

Terms & Conditions

1. The applicant must agree to abide by all rules, as amended from time to time by the Organizer in its sole discretion.
2. The applicant should be between (16 – 29 years as of 31st December 2021) & 5 Feet and above in height.
3. The applicant must produce the following:
Nationality Proof: Passport (preferred option) or Aadhar Card or Voters ID or Driving License
State Eligibility Proof: the below-mentioned eligibility proof is required to apply from:
 1. Birth State: Birth Certificate or Passport
 2. Current State: Employment Certificate / Employment ID Card or House Rental Document or College ID or Gas / Electricity Bill
 3. Native State: Parents' Residential Proof documents e.g. House / Rent Agreement or Gas Bill or Electricity Bill or Phone Bill or Employment Certificate / Employment ID Card or Birth Certificate or Passport - on either of your parents' name
4. The applicant uses the prefix 'Miss'(or equivalent) before her name. The applicant should not / have not been married and never been through any ceremony directly or indirectly, either valid or invalid, whether civil, religious, or tribal which is recognized as a marriage ceremony in any part of the world and should never have had a marriage annulled or never given birth to a child; have never been pregnant nor been a parent.
5. The applicant should be a natural-born female.
6. The applicant should be a Bonafede Indian citizen, holding a valid Indian passport, and should be a resident of India as per the applicable laws of India.
7. The applicant or the applicant's immediate family should not be related to any person employed in Sponsor Companies, or any of the judges as informed to the applicant at any stage. In case of such a relation, the applicant must disclose the same immediately.

8. If the applicant is under any commercial contract with any modeling agency at the time of appearing for the auditions, she should declare it on email before she auditions virtually for the pageant.
9. The applicant once shortlisted cannot be a part of any other commercial contract or pageant. If already under any contract, then she should declare the same to the Organization before auditions.
10. The Organizers are not responsible for any delays or non-receipt of applications on any account and any reason whatsoever.
11. The applicant should not have been qualified for or taken part in any contest as a representative of any country other than India
12. The applicant will have to participate in a disciplined and diligent manner throughout as per schedule for auditions and screening.
13. Any profile or material asked by the Organization stating the applicant's information should be shared with the Organization on an immediate basis.
14. The Organizer shall not be responsible if the sponsors do not make good the prizes promised by them.
15. The Organizer shall not be responsible for any loss or physical injury that occurs to the applicant on account of their participation in the event. The applicant will participate at her own risk and can have no claim company in any regard.
16. The applicant acknowledges that any incorrect information shall result in disqualification, whether discovered before, during, or after participation.
17. The decision of the judges shall be final in all cases and the applicant does not in any capacity question the same on any platform and no correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.
18. The applicant cannot disclose any information or record or discuss the screening process or judges' comments with any third party.
19. The applicant cannot get in touch with any judge during the judging process.
20. If an applicant has a personal connection with any judge the applicant must declare it during the auditions to the contestant managers.
21. Any screening/audition footage or results internally declared or confidential information given by the Organization cannot be shared by the applicant with any social media /digital page or with any person related to such platforms.

22. The applicant shall be in good health, sound mind, and have a good moral character to be eligible to participate in the contest.
23. The applicant should not have any cases (criminal or civil) registered against her.
24. The schedule of the events and qualification rounds are subject to change at the discretion of the Organizer.
25. The applicant is selected as one of the State Winners will have to sign the legal contract with the Organization. The contract must be submitted 24-48 hours from the time it is handed over to the applicant.
26. The 1st runner-up titleholder could be eligible to represent India at Miss Apsaras in case the winner is unable to go for any reason.
27. All the content especially the audition tasks produced on the Social media cannot be cross-promoted on any other competing short video content app unless notified or consented by the Miss Apsaras team.
28. The Organizers are not responsible for the non-completion / non-occurrence of the event.
29. In the event of any dispute, the Organizers' decisions are final and binding on the applicant.
